### Conductor's Report

The unusual form of AGM this year did not really give me the chance to put forward my plans for the coming season as I usually do so I am taking this opportunity to let everyone know what I'm planning for the rest of this year's practice sessions in preparation for "dancing out".

It has been much easier to plan Thursday nights this year because attendance has been much more consistent. Also, I have been told in advance if anyone cannot attend. Consequently, we have achieved as much in the past few weeks as we often do all winter!

You will already have noticed that I am concentrating on the two Number 2 dances and Royton at the moment. I want to have everyone able to process using Royton (including as many figures of the stationary dance as possible). Also, I am sure we can have Number 2 Garland ready for April. In Number 2 Polka I am hoping that those who have been doing this for some time will be able to dance in different positions when necessary to allow for (i) those just learning it and (ii) the fact that Peter is likely to have to be a musician (!) on some occasions. I hope to extend the tidying up of this dance and removal of inconsistencies to Deane Memorial and Holme Chapel early in the New Year. I have no plans for the Polka and Garland dances other than to run through them before we first dance out.
